

Step 4. Stakeholder Mapping

Objective:

Identify all stakeholders that are needed to fulfil the purpose.

Instructions:

1. Individually, start thinking about any stakeholder that should be involved at any given time in the project
2. Write each stakeholder in a separate post in the color that corresponds to the quadruple helix
3. Move it to the matrix where you think it belongs
4. If the stakeholder is already in the board, put your post on top of the existing one
5. As a group, discuss the stakeholders on the board and identify if any are missing.
6. Select the most important stakeholders in each quadrant and add a red star next to each of them.


